PCR SUPPLEMENT 206-4
1 APRIL 2017
DUTY ASSIGNMENT ROTATION

Per the new CAPR 206-4 all Duty Assignments are now subject to rotation in order to give our members the most positive CAP experience possible. Since Wing Commanders exert the most control, and therefore generate the most IG complaints for abuse of authority, the Pacific Region will begin this rotation with those so assigned. This will allow a minimal time for them to aggravate members and should result in a reduction in complaints, as well as give the Wing Commanders an opportunity to work with different cultures. Commanders will not have time to actually cause any problems, therefore Abuse of Authority complaints are expected to vanish.

Rotations will occur on a 3 month basis which will allow the most positive exposure. The following rotations be effective 1 April and continue on every three (3) months (Quarterly);

Alaska Wing Commander rotates to Hawaii.
Hawaii Wing Commander rotates to California.
California Wing Commander rotates to Nevada.
Nevada Wing Commander rotates to Oregon.
Oregon Wing Commander rotates to Washington.
Washington Wing Commander rotates to Alaska.

On 1 July;

The Alaska Wing Commander (formerly the Washington Wing Commander) rotates to Hawaii.
The Hawaii Wing Commander (formerly the Alaska Wing Commander) rotates to Washington.
The California Wing Commander (formerly the Hawaii Wing Commander) rotates to Alaska.
The Nevada Wing Commander (formerly the California Wing Commander) rotates to Oregon.
The Oregon Wing Commander (formerly the Nevada Wing Commander) rotates to California.
The Washington Wing Commander (formerly the Oregon Wing Commander) rotates to Nevada.

Additional rotation schedules will be announced NLT 1 June to accommodate trades in housing etc. Wing Commanders should develop similar schedules for Groups and Groups for squadrons. These will take effect 1 October 2017 to reflect the next fiscal year. Rotated Wing Commanders should plan these schedules based on future rotation, so be prepared to think outside of the box.
